Conditions of Entry - 2020

- 1. The organisers of this event are the committee of Wyong Creek Literary Institute Inc. (Wyong Creek Hall).
- 2. Entrants must agree to have their artwork displayed and offered for sale during the period 28 August 30 September 2020.
- 3. An Entry Fee is payable on each piece of 9x5 artwork submitted.
- 4. A selling commission of 20% of the sale price will apply.
- 5. Artist's name, title, medium and price must be on the back of all artwork.
- 6. All artwork must be on the unframed 9x5 art boards supplied by the organisers.
- 7. Artwork may be in any medium.
- 8. Artwork may have any theme.
- 9. The organisers reserve the right to reject unsuitable or offensive artwork.
- 10. While utmost care will be exercised, the organisers will not be held responsible for the loss or damage to any artwork.
- 11. Insurance of all artwork is the responsibility of the artist.
- 12. All artwork must be in the hands of the organisers no later than Wednesday 26 August 2020. Artwork received after this date may not be accepted.
- 13. All submitted artwork may be photographed for promotional purposes.

Entry Details

- 1. After completing and lodging your Entry Form with payment, by any of the means detailed on that **Entry Form**, your 9x5 art board(s) will be either posted to you, or if lodging "by hand" then given to you at Alison Homestead by staff.
- On completion of your artwork(s), it may be lodged directly with Alison Homestead at 1Cape Rd. Wyong, or posted to Di Salmon 822Yarramalong Rd Wyong Creek NSW 2259 prior to Wednesday 26 August.
- 3 All 9x5 Art Prize winners will be notified of their winnings on Friday 28 August.
- 4. During the exhibition period, artists who's artworks have been sold, will be notified and payment forwarded to them.
- 5. At the end of the exhibition period (30 September 2020), all unsold artwork may be collected from Alison Homestead, or returned by post on payment of \$10.00
